

Modelling - an instructional strategy in which the teacher demonstrates a new concept or approach to learning and pupils learn by observing & imitating.



- * Prepare - know what you will say, write & think out loud. It's difficult to 'ad lib' modelling well.
- * Share your thoughts - talk pupils through your actions and your thought processes.
- * Model mistakes - show pupils what it's like to encounter problems & strategies to overcome them.
- * Use questions - "What am I doing?", "Why am I doing it?" Ensure pupils really understand.
- * Use multiple exemplars - Celebrate multiple successful methods & promote creativity.
