Supporting Functional Skills Learners (English)

This course will help participants to develop a range of strategies to help learners studying for Functional Skills English level 1 and level 2. The course focuses on the key areas which examiners and tutors have identified as being areas learners find more challenging. The course will use a range of everyday texts as used in the examinations to explore how to develop learners reading and writing skills.

Training aim:

The course focuses developing a range of teaching and learning approaches relating to key areas which learners find challenging and which impact on their progress: vocabulary development, using effective sentences, spellings, accessing a text for information and developing their writing.

Who is the course for?

This course is primarily aimed at subject specialist teachers of Functional English but it may also be of interest to other practitioners working in the post-16 sector who will be supporting the development of learners' Functional Skills, such as learning support assistants.

Learning outcomes:

Develop teaching and learning approaches which:

- Develop learners' knowledge of grammar to write effective, accurate sentences.
- Help learners to write coherently and cohesively using planning approaches and paragraphs to create clear meaning and structure
- Use post-16 phonics approaches to supporting learners' spellings
- Develop learners' vocabulary
- Help learners to access texts by developing a range of reading approaches which engage them and develop their reading skills
