



Attendance and Motivation: English

This course will focus on how to engage and motivate learners to attend and remain on English courses and will include supporting learners remotely and issues surrounding resilience and self-efficacy. The course will support practitioners to use innovative approaches to engage learners in reading and writing, drawing on recent practitioner research findings (from OTLA 6).

Training aim:

This course will:

- Outline the principles behind the AfL effective practice guidelines
- Discuss how to support learners to see the relevance of English for their lives and work
- Investigate how to match teaching to the needs of learners and how coaching strategies can support teaching practice and encourage learners to engage.
