English: Improving Writing

This course will draw on best practice approaches to develop writing skills to produce coherent and cohesive texts which respond effectively to examination and occupational tasks: answers to reading questions, transactional and creative writing tasks.

Training aim:

This course aims to help learners overcome the barriers to writing they often face so they can focus on developing their writing skills to create texts fit for purpose. Learners will see how effective writing can empower them to communicate their interests and ideas to a wide audience.

Who is the course for?

This course is for tutors who teach GCSE, Functional Skills English or other tutors who need to develop learners' writing skills.

Learning outcomes:

By the end of the session you will have:

- Using the natural writing process to overcome barriers: generating ideas, creating plans and drafts.
- Refining writing by developing knowledge of vocabulary, grammar and paragraphing.
- Consider how different approaches impact on what they want to say and who they want to influence.
